Webelos 2's are eligible, even if they have already crossed over to Boy Scouts.

Registration begins at 9:45 am and will continue throughout the day by division level. Cool Cars may register anytime before 2:00. Scouts will race by division level. Racing will begin at 10:30 am and conclude around 3:15 pm. Food and beverages will be available throughout the day.

Pinewood Derby Rules will be the Official Appalachian Trail District Pinewood Derby Rules, which are available at www.wmascouting.org. Registration may be completed either by submitting the paper registration or submitting an electronic registration through the website.

Each car will race three (3) times. The lowest cumulative time will be the winner. The top three winners will be recognized in each division level.

The Cool Car competition is for Cubs of any level. Four Cubs from a pack are allowed. The Pack can choose their participants in any manner they choose. A Cub cannot enter both the Race and the Cool Car Division – it must be one or the other. Awards will also be given in the Cool Car division.

Each Pack can send up to 19 scouts. 3 each in the Tiger, Wolf, Bear, Webelos 1, Webelos 2 racers divisions and 4 in the Cool Car division.

Cost is \$5.00 per scout.
