The deadline is firm!!! Food and supplies need to be ordered so that we can ensure we have enough for everyone who wants to participate. Please submit your rosters as early as possible. We also need to assign the groups for the activities and we want to avoid the confusion we have had in years past and set all that up ahead!!

REGISTRATION FEES

Fees are based on anticipated expenses for the event. The fee includes a patch, a certificate, lunch, dinner, activity supplies, insurance and other costs for every pre-registered participant. As well as overnight accommodations (bunk in a cabin or tenting) for those who chose to stay. Tenting is always an option; however, safety regulations require that a bunk be made available to every overnight participant.

Day program \$17.00 pp
(includes activities, lunch, dinner, hayride & campfire)

Day and Overnight program \$27.00 pp
(includes bunk in cabin and breakfast)

Registration's received after September 17th will incur a \$10.00 late fee/per person.

Registration on the day of the event will incur a \$15.00 late fee/per person (No overnight registrations will be accepted)

REGISTRATION

Pre-registration is expected. The deadline for the overnight program is FIRM....NO EXCEPTIONS!! Cabin and tenting assignments need to be arranged prior to the event and will be issued at check in. It truly helps when we know how many to expect. Plus, pre-registration also helps save a ton of time at check in. We are requesting only the number of registrants at the time of pre-registration. The event staff realizes that there will be additions and deletions to some rosters. You can add or delete Scouts and Leaders for the day activities at the event at the time of check-in. There will be no refunds for cancelled Scouts or Packs. There will be separate check in for day participants and overnight participants. Overnight participants should bring their gear to check in with them and we will deliver it to your assigned cabin during the day. PLEASE CHECK IN AS A UNIT, SEND 1 REPRESENTATIVE WHEN ALL YOUR UNIT HAS ARRIVED.

CHECK-IN AND CHECK-OUT PROCEDURES

Check-in will be between 8:00a.m. and 9:00a.m. on Saturday morning on the deck of the Nunes building. Wristbands will be issued at check-in. Opening activities will start promptly at 9:00a.m.

Saturday check out will be at 8:30 pm and Sunday check out will be after breakfast.

GENERAL RULES

- The Scout Law is the main rule of all Scout events
- The use of event facilities is a privilege – Be respectful of all property
- All vehicles must be parked in the Parade field (if there is overflow then Jason will let us know where to park)
- There are to be NO ground fires – fires are only allowed in designated fire rings
- No holes or trenches may be dug in the ground for any reason. No exceptions!!
- All recyclable trash must be placed in recycle bins
- No trees, shrubs or bushes – living or dead – may be cut or removed without explicit permission
- The buddy system is to be used always during the event
- No Scout may leave the event unless arranged in advance with the unit leader
- As at any Scout event, no drugs, alcohol, firearms or weapons may be on the premises at any time. Possession of any of these items is grounds for immediate dismissal.
- Please report ALL accidents, injuries and other emergencies to the First Aid Station!! (First Aid station will be downstairs at the Nunes building). **ALL First Aid needs shall be handled in the First Aid station...NO EXCEPTIONS!**
- Please turn in any lost and found items to a staff member
- In case of an emergency you will hear a long horn blast. At that time please report to the dining hall for further instructions.
