B = BASIC, very basic training for new Cub Scout leaders with little or no camping experience.

A = ADULT, the adult training requirement for those planning and participating in your Pack's camping experiences.

L = LEADER, open to all registered leaders, Tiger Parent and Leader to Webelos Leader, Cubmaster to Committee Member. And open to interested adults as well.

O = OUTDOOR, tents, mosquitoes, cooking, campfire program, woods-tools safety, more.

O = ORIENTATION, very basic "how-to" introduction focusing on planning a safe overnight experience for your Pack or den.
