

!!! WINTER ICE USE!!!

It is up to the Registered Adult of each group, troop, crew or private organizations, to make sure the ICE is a minimum of 5 inches thick throughout their entire area of use.

***No Scouting use, if ice is under
5" Inches thick.***

"ALL." If your group or members of your group are on the ICE.

Your group NEEDs a RESCUE DEVICE with them.

IE: Length of rope 50' feet.

Throwable rescue float (PFD vest) rope attached / carabiner.

Ladder, Long board, branch (+10'-15+' feet long).

Plastic sled with rope attached.

A human chain is only needed if you have not complied with the winter use rules. Good luck out there and have fun.

Be safe, enjoy the safe ice.
